

## **Annual Report – 2025**

Good Morning ladies and gentlemen and a warm welcome to our Annual Sports Day cum Prize Distribution “Invictus”. It gives me immense pleasure to welcome our Chief Guest Smt Sandhya Rani Mehta IPS, DIG Budget and our Guest of Honour Col. Ravi Kant Kushwaha, CO, 6/8 Gorkha Rifles.

I would like to thank you for accepting our invitation and gracing us with your presence. A very warm welcome to the parents and families who are here to support their children. A warm welcome to our distinguished guests and friends from the press and media.

At the very outset I would like to take this opportunity to thank our school Secretary Mr. Jashadeb Chaudhuri for his unwavering and continued support in all our endeavours. I also want to thank our Managing Committee members for all their help and support in taking the school to greater heights.

Ladies and gentlemen it gives me immense pleasure to present to you the annual report of Surendranath Centenary School Ranchi. We set standards and goals for ourselves and strive hard to achieve them, be it in the areas of academics, sports or co curricular activities.

As we step into the 39<sup>th</sup> year we are steady with 3200 students from different walks of life. Under RTE category we have enrolled 06 students at the entry level and have a total of 106 students on roll.

While the number of students have remained steady there has been considerable increase in teaching faculty. We are today with 116 full time teachers and 4 part time teachers. We also have a big team of 40 non teaching staff who work with dedication and sincerity. We constantly try to achieve excellence. Our efficient and dedicated teachers, hard working and diligent students and supportive parents make this possible.

It is with great pride that I inform that a total of 192 candidates appeared for the Senior Secondary Certificate Exam 2025. The highest aggregate in Science was secured by Rishika Agarwal which was 98% and by Kashish in Commerce which was 98.4%. 29 students secured above 90%. 183 students secured 1<sup>st</sup> division marks which is about 95.3%. The highest marks 100 was secured in Chemistry, Business Studies, Painting and Entrepreneurship while the school average was 79.9%.

In the Secondary School Examination 2025 a total of 243 students took the examination. The highest marks was secured by Aashi Sinha with 99.2% and she has also secured the 2<sup>nd</sup> rank in the state level. Trisha Pandey stood second with 97.8% and Kamil Adab stood 3<sup>rd</sup> with 97.6%. 81 students secured above 90% marks, while 238 students secured 1<sup>st</sup> division marks. The school average was 79.15%. Full marks that is 100% was secured in Science, Social Science, Sanskrit and Artificial Intelligence.

The recipient for the coveted Amala Goswami Award is none other than Sonit Shandilya . He secured 97.4% in the Secondary School Examination 2025 and was the Vice Captain of the Panther House. He has received the Manak Inspire Award at the district level for his model “rain protector for 2 wheelers” a keen quizzard .He has received 1<sup>st</sup> prize in several quiz competitions and has also participated in several Science Exhibitions held at BIT, Mesra. The Ranadeb Chaudhuri Endowment for the topper in Science goes to Rishika Agarwal with an

impressive 98% and Mira Chaudhuri Endowment for securing the highest marks in Commerce goes to Kashish for having secured 98.4%.

In addition to commendable academic results the students have been steadily competing and getting selected into higher professional colleges of education. Tejaswi Raj is presently studying in NIT Trichi, Harsh Mehta is a student of BIT Sindri, Mechanical Branch, Ananya Rai is a proud student of IIT (ISM) Dhanbad and pursuing Chemical Engineering, Kumari Unnati and Antra are students of ITER, Bhubaneswar and are studying Computer Science Engineering. Our student Priyal Gupta has cleared CLAT and is now a student of NLU (Ranchi). Dheeraj Kumar is a student of IIIT Ranchi and in the ECE Branch. Arushi Lejan Tete is doing B.Sc-M.Sc Dual Degree from Indian Institute of Science Education and Research and Shrishti Sinha is doing MBA from BIT Mesra. Ojshwi is pursuing B.Tech in Computer Science in SRM College KTR campus. Pratham Pandey cleared CA Foundation Exam in his first attempt. Last but not the least Soumili is pursuing MBBS in IQ Medical College and Hospital Durgapur, Rishika Agarwal is pursuing Economics Honors and Ayush Jain is pursuing B. Com Honors with St. Xavier's College Kolkata.

Our NCC cadets are enrolled with 19<sup>th</sup> Jharkhand Battalion. In our 6<sup>th</sup> year 25 cadets have been enrolled. A total of 175 cadets have successfully completed the A certificate.

The school strongly encourages learning by doing. To provide ample exposure to experiential learning, the school has partnered for a five year long initiative with the Adani Cement FutureX to uphold the spirit of sustainable innovation and collaboration. This partnership aims at developing India's next generation of leaders and innovators by connecting classrooms with real world industry and sustainability challenges. This collaboration focuses on bridging the gap between school education and employability & entrepreneurial skills.

Students would thus be entitled to priority access to internships , leadership events, visits to the plant and many other collaborative opportunities under the guidance of technical and industry experts from Adani Cement.

Atal Tinkering Lab which started in 2020 is a place for creativity, innovation and curiosity. Our school received the month of the school award for April, May and July 2025. In the National Technology Day held at BIT Mesra, our students Abhik Kumar, Vedant Jha, Abhighyan Sen Gupta and Arnab Aggarwal won the 3<sup>rd</sup> prize for their model “Fire Fighting Robot”.

The best practices carried out by the Community Outreach Club is the Book Donation Camp where books and stationery were collected in the month of April and handed over to Ramakrishna Mission to be handed over to community learning centres. With the onset of winter there was a woolen clothes donation drive ‘Rahat’ for the inmates of Guru Nanak Handicapped Home, Ranchi. These initiatives bridge gaps between the have and have nots in society.

In the Inspire Manak Awards organized by Government of India Ministry of Science and Technology, Rishit Jha of Class VI A has been selected to represent Jharkhand at the National Level. His model is ‘Smart Material Collection Bin for Low Construction Waste’. He has also received Rs 10000/- to upgrade his model.

In the Aryabhata Ganit Challenge Rishav Kumar, Kamil Adab and Lucky Adhyan of Class X were selected as the top 100 from the Patna Region.

In the Model United Nations Competition held at G.D. Goenka Public School and DPS Ranchi Harshvi Shah and Mahi Sharma have stood 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> respectively.

In the online Slogan Writing Competition organized by the Government of India, Illinia Priyansha of Class IX won the consolation prize and was the only student from Jharkhand State. While in the DOX Competition held at

St. Xavier's School Doranda, our students won the Championship Trophy for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time. In the Poster Designing Competition organized by the National Academy of Direct Taxes, Shreya Hazra of Class X won the 2<sup>nd</sup> prize at the National Level. Akshita Jyotirmay of Class VIII won the 2<sup>nd</sup> prize in the Recitation Competition at Jharkhand State Level organized by Ramakrishna Mission Ranchi on the occasion of National Youth Day. She also received a cash award of Rs. 3000/- .

Our students have won several prizes at Inter School Competitions held at ILCC, Vanya Prani Week organized by the Forest Department, Ranchi and Sahodaya Complex Inter School Competitions.

Ishaan Kumar of VIII A and Kamil Adab of X B have won cash awards of Rs 5000/- and zonal gold medal for their outstanding performance in English Olympiad 2025 and Neetigya Bhardwaj also won a cash award of Rs 5000/- and the zonal certificate of excellence for Science Olympiad.

It's a moment of pride for us at Surendranath Centenary School Ranchi that Aman Chamola of Class XII C represented Jharkhand at the Vikshit Bharat Young Leaders Dialogue 2026 before the Indian Ministry at Bharat Mandapam Delhi. He was selected from a group of 50 lakh applications.

It's not only in the field of studies but also in the field of Sports that our students have excelled. In the Badminton Association Ranchi District Championship Avyansh Gupta of Class XI won the 2<sup>nd</sup> prize. In the 3<sup>rd</sup> Inter School Badminton Tournament Moksh Kejriwal, Pratyush Kumar, Nikunj Shukla and Ashutosh Kumar were placed 3<sup>rd</sup>. Similarly our Table Tennis Wizards Faizal Khan and Alisaad Khan won 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> rank at the Table Tennis Championship held at Oxford School. In the Inter School Championship at G.D. Goenka Public School, Alisaad and Faizal Khan stood 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> respectively. Finally Faizal

Khan stood 2<sup>nd</sup> in the under 11 category in the Ranchi District Table Tennis Championship.

Shanvi Shaw of Class I secured 1<sup>st</sup> position in Yoga Championship in Deshapriya Club Ranchi.
